Criteria

The Dr. Joseph Kraut, Jr. Memorial Scholarship is in memory of Dr. Kraut who was an example of what every physician should be: compassionate, intelligent, respectful and well-liked by colleagues, employees, patients and community members. He was dedicated to the South Santa Clara County and San Benito County communities, especially wanting to provide care for the less fortunate.

This scholarship is meant to inspire and support medical school students who aspire for a career in Primary Care.

Criteria

- Applicants, who were born, raised or graduated from a high school in either South Santa Clara County or San Benito County, California.
- Applicants must be a college senior and accepted to medical school or currently enrolled full-time in an accredited medical school program.
- Applicants must demonstrate personal motivation for excellence in both character and academic achievement. Personal integrity, as exemplified by leadership, community involvement and concern for others, will be considered.

Special Considerations

- Applicants are encouraged to have plans to work in South Santa Clara County or San Benito County Area in California in the practice of Primary Care.
- "Need" based applicants will be given preference when applying.

Payment

When recipient is registered at a medical school, payment will be made directly to the educational institution. Students need to send proof of registration, name, student ID number and address of school to:

Application Instructions:

1. Return a completed scholarship application form, including the personal statement.
2. Application must be signed and dated.
3. Include two Letters of Recommendation (sealed) from college professors, dated within 6 months of application deadline.
4. Include one Letter of Recommendation from a professional mentor, dated within 6 months of application deadline.
5. Include an **official** college transcript. If applicant has taken medical school courses, an **official** medical school transcript must also be included for all work completed. No photocopies will be accepted.
