

Robert J. Galaviz Memorial Scholarship Criteria 2023

Scholarship Award: This scholarship is a \$500 award.

Specific Requirements:

- The recipient must be a graduate of a GUSD high school.
- The recipient must attend San Jose State University.
- The recipient must have graduated high school with at least a 3.0 GPA.
- The recipient must have participated in high school sports.
- The recipient must have a minimum of 50 hours of community service during their high school years.
- It is preferred that the recipient be of Mexican descent: The recipient, a parent, or a grandparent having been born in Mexico.

Applicants must submit the following documents:

1. Completed GUSD Common Scholarship Application.
2. Three letters of recommendation: two letters from a staff member-teacher, ACs, APS, and one letter from a community service supervisor (non-school staff member nor relative).
3. A copy of the applicant's unofficial high school transcript.

The application is due by **March 3, 2023**.

Determination of Award: Gilroy Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee will choose the recipient each year. Gilroy Foundation will notify the winning students in April. The scholarship must be redeemed by December 15, 2023, or be forfeited.
