

CRITERIA FOR THE 2024 GILROY FOUNDATION'S YOUTH BOARD COMPETITIVE GRANT

Note: Applicants for the Youth Board grant **ARE** also eligible to apply for a Gilroy Foundation Competitive Grant for the same year.

APPLICANT CRITERIA

Youth, Therapeutic Animal Services, Rescue Animal Services, or the Senior Citizen Community Programs.

GRANT RANGE: \$500 - \$1,000

2024 TIMELINE

Upcoming grant round: Grant deadline is December 15, 2023 at 12AM.Application reviews and grantee announcements will take place in March 2024. We suggest that you email grants@gilroyfoundation.org to assure it's arrival.

ELIGIBILITY

In reviewing and authorizing grants, the Foundation gives preference to projects of the following types, whether undertaken by existing agencies or by new agencies.

- Organizations must serve South Santa Clara County/Specifially Gilroy and the surrounding area or San Martin and Morgan Hill
- Organizations must have a 501(c)(3) designation or have a fiscal sponsor with a 501(c)(3) designation.
- Organizations must not discriminate based on race, color, national origin, citizenship status, creed, religion, religious affiliation, age gender, marital status, sexual orientation, gender identity, disability, veteran status or any other protected status.
- Organizations with religious affiliations will be considered for funding only if the project for which they seek support addresses the needs of the wider community without regard to religious beliefs.

FUNDING EXEMPTIONS

Funding will not be provided for:

Capital Improvements

Budget shortfalls or fundraising events

Previously planned or long-term campaigns

Funding gaps due to organizational emergencies, such as office vandalism, resignation of an executive director or sudden loss of funding

The application is streamlined to reduce time spent on applying and processing. The grant review process will be expedited and only one application may be submitted per organization.
